**NOTICE TO HOMEOWNERS
CUSTOMER SERVICE INSPECTION REQUIRED**

Rose Hill Special Utility District, (hereafter called utility) hereby notifies all plumbers and homeowners that all water utility's in the state of Texas must comply with the rules and regulations of the Texas Commission on Environment Quality (TCEQ) concerning construction and renovation of additions and modifications to private plumbing facilities.

Rose Hill Special Utility District has adopted the following rules as the prevailing guide for plumbing facility construction and modification standards, particularly regarding the prohibition of the use of lead solder and fittings and the prohibition of cross-connections within the plumbing system. By execution of these documents, the homeowner certifies that all plumbing meets, to the best of their knowledge, the following conditions on the date executed below.

- 1.) No direct connection between the public drinking water supply and potential source of contamination exist. Potential sources of contamination are isolated from the public water supply system by an air-gap or an appropriate back-flow prevention assembly in accordance with the state plumbing regulations. Additionally, all pressure relief valves and thermal expansion devices are in compliance with state plumbing codes.
- 2.) No cross-connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system or well exists. Where an actual air gap is not maintained between the public water supply and a private water supply, an approved reduced pressure-zone back-flow prevention assembly is properly installed. A service agreement shall be maintained according to the utilities rules for annual inspection and testing by a certified back-flow prevention device tester.
- 3.) No connection exist which would allow the return of water used for condensing; cooling or industrial processes back to the public water supply.
- 4.) No pipe or pipefitting, which contains more than 8%, lead exists in the private plumbing facilities installed on or after July 1, 1988.
- 5.) No solder or flux, which contains more than 0.2% lead, exists in the private plumbing installed on or after July 1, 1988.

This document will be related as part of the utilities permanent files. By execution hereof, I certify that the foregoing is true and correct and that I am legally responsible of the validity of the information I have provided. I, also, understand that the utility will inspect all private plumbing facilities and that the **homeowner** must be present to demonstrate compliance.

Your inspection is scheduled for _____, 20____ at _____ am-pm. **Failure to complete the inspection within 14 days is grounds for immediate discontinuance of service.** A \$50.00 customer inspection (CC & BP) fee will be collected at the time of service request. **An additional \$50.00 will be charged for missed appointments unless the owner calls to reschedule at least 1 hour before the appointment time. Failure to pass the follow-up inspection will result in immediate discontinuance of service.**
